A regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of West Goshen Township was called to order by Chairman Raymond Halvorsen at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 9, 2012 at the West Goshen Township Administration Building. Mr. Halvorsen opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Lieutenant Greg Stone gave the Police Report for the month of April 2012.

Ms. Andrea Testa, Fire Marshal, gave the Fire Marshal Report for the month of April 2012. Ms. Testa also gave the report for Good Fellowship Ambulance Company and the Goshen Fire Company.

Ms. Andrea Testa, Fire Marshall, also gave the Building Inspection Activity Report for April 2012.

Mr. Halvorsen opened the floor for public comment. There was none at this time.

Mr. Murphy stated that the Township was planning on a public meeting with the Township's Traffic Advisory Committee to discuss the Roslyn traffic situation. Following this public Traffic Advisory Committee meeting, the Committee will formally present its findings to the Board of Supervisors at a future Board meeting. Residents in the Roslyn neighborhood and surrounding neighborhoods will be invited to both the Traffic Advisory Committee meeting and the Board of Supervisors' meeting to provide comment.

Mr. LaLonde stated that PennDOT was about to begin the Grove Road improvement project north of West Goshen Township in West Whiteland Township. The project includes drainage improvements and the milling and repaving of the road surface. Mr. Halvorsen stated that the project will include temporary road closures on Grove Road and that an approved PennDOT detour plan is in place. Residents are advised to find an alternate route to work or school due to the construction and its probable vehicle delays.

On motion by Mr. Murphy, seconded by Mrs. McIlvaine, the Board approved the Board of Supervisors minutes dated April 25, 2012.

On motion by Mr. Corvo, seconded by Dr. White, the Board approved the Treasurer's Report dated April 30, 2012 for the General Fund, the Sewer Revenue Fund, the Waste and Recycling Fund, and the Capital Reserve Fund, as well as the bills to be paid from the General Fund, the Sewer Fund, the Capitol Reserve Fund and the Waste and Recycling Fund.

On a motion by Mrs. McIlvaine, seconded by Mr. Murphy, the Board authorized execution of the 2012 Pavement Marking Contract for Alpha Space Control in the amount of \$62,644.14.

On a motion by Dr. White, seconded by Mr. Halvorsen, the Board authorized execution of the 2012 Asphalt Paving Contract for Allan A. Myers in the amount of \$1,200,000.00.

On a motion by Mr. Halvorsen, seconded by Mr. Murphy, the Board authorized the final one-year extension of the existing Waste and Recycling Contract with Republic Services. Mr. Halvorsen explained that this extension is for

the fifth and final year of the current Waste and Recycling contract and that Republic Services was seeking a five percent (5%) increase for this last one-year extension. Given current diesel prices and our existing contract's pricing, the increase is reasonable.

There being no further business, on motion by Mr. Halvorsen, seconded by Mr. Murphy, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
