

**WEST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
FEBRUARY 12, 2014**

A regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of West Goshen Township was called to order by Chairman Patricia McIlvaine at 7:05 p.m. on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at the West Goshen Township Administration Building. Mrs. McIlvaine opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Captain Greg Stone gave the Police Report for the month of January 2014.

Ms. Andrea Testa, Fire Marshal, gave the Fire Marshal Report for the month of January 2014. Ms. Testa also gave the report for Good Fellowship Ambulance Company and the Goshen Fire Company.

Ms. Testa also gave the Building Inspection Activity Report for January 2014.

Mrs. McIlvaine announced that the Board of Supervisors held an executive session on February 12, 2014 to discuss personnel.

On a motion by Dr. White, seconded by Mr. Corvo, the Board voted 3-1 with Mr. Murphy opposed to hold a special meeting to discuss the Roslyn traffic situation as part of the regular monthly Board of Supervisors meeting.

Dr. White also announced that the Township was engaged in detailed conversations with West Chester University regarding the improvement and opening of Tigue Road to relieve traffic congestion in the southern portion of West Goshen Township.

On a motion by Mr. Corvo, seconded by Dr. White, the Board unanimously approved the Board of Supervisors meeting minutes of January 6, 2014.

On a motion by Dr. White, seconded by Mrs. McIlvaine, the Board unanimously approved the Treasurer's Report dated January 31, 2014, for the General Fund, the Sewer Revenue Fund, the Waste and Recycling Fund, and the Capital Reserve Fund, and the bills to be paid from these funds.

On a motion by Mr. Murphy, seconded by Dr. White, the Board unanimously approved Resolution 5 – 2014, dedicating the roadways in the Quaker Ridge subdivision, effective March 31, 2014.

On a motion by Mr. Murphy, seconded by Dr. White, the Board unanimously approved Resolution 4 – 2014, Agreement to Authorize Electronic Access to PennDOT Systems for Township personnel.

On a motion by Mrs. McIlvaine, seconded by Dr. White, the Board unanimously approved a budget memorandum detailing the additional expenditure for emergency repairs to the storm water system in the Fresh Meadows neighborhood in the amount of \$108,000.

On a motion by Dr. White, seconded by Mr. Murphy, the Board unanimously approved the Wawa / CVS Conditional Use Order for the property at 1010 West Chester Pike. Conditions imposed by the Board of Supervisors include, but are not limited to: delivery restrictions; no music played over loudspeakers at the gas pumps; and traffic improvements that include traffic calming measures on South Five Points Road and signal timing improvements on West Chester Pike.

Mr. Abbas Rahabi, 1613 Manley Road, East Goshen Township, appeared with and acted as a spokesperson for Mr. Robert Brochet, 600 Warren Road, regarding snow removal at his property. Mr. Rahabi stated that Mr.

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Brochet has complained to the Township for many years regarding snow removal at his residence. The claims include speeding plow trucks, excess amounts of snow dumped on his property, excess snow being plowed on his sidewalk and driveway and into his mailbox.

Mr. Corvo requested Mr. Craig project several photographs taken of Mr. Brochet's intersection. Mr. Corvo stated and displayed that Mr. Brochet's corner property received no more or less snow deposition than the other three corners and suggested Mr. Brochet move his mailbox from the apex of the curve to a position closer to his driveway. Mr. Corvo then showed a photo of his own property with several feet of snow piled at his mailbox and that it is a routine situation for snow to pile up due to plowing operations.

There being no further business, on motion by Mr. Murphy, seconded by Dr. White, the meeting was adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
